REGULATIONS

- 1 THE Show will be open to members and the public at 8.00 am.
- 2 ADMISSION prices to the Showground will be as set by the Society.
Vehicles will only occupy such position on the Showground as may be set apart for them by the Society.
- 3 ANY dispute as to the interpretation of these Regulations and any other By-Laws, Rules or Provisions shall be determined by the Directors whose decision shall be final.
- 4 THE Society shall have the power to refuse admittance to the Showground of any exhibit or exhibitor for any valid reason it sees fit and such decision shall be final.
- 5 THE Society will give every possible facility to exhibitors and every care will be taken in respect of exhibits, but NO RESPONSIBILITY WILL BE INCURRED BY THE SOCIETY.
- 6 IN the event of any person occupying any stand on the Showground or any exhibit or exhibitor causing offensive noises or in any way whatsoever interfering with the comfort of the patrons, the Society shall have the power to cancel the occupancy of the stand and to have the exhibit or exhibitor responsible removed from the Showground.
- 7 SKILFUL persons appointed by the Society will be chosen to act as judges of the various sections. The judge's decision in all cases shall be final except if it be opposed to the Regulations or any other By-Laws, Rules or Provisions of the Society, or any valid protest or objection is lodged in accordance with the Regulations.
- 8 PROTESTS or objections must be in writing, accompanied by a deposit of \$20.00 and lodged with the Secretary within ONE HOUR of the judge's decision. The deposit will be forfeited to the Society unless the protest or objection is upheld.
- 9 PROTESTS or objections shall be heard by the Protest Committee consisting of the President, Past President, Secretary and the Chief Steward of the relevant section, with power to co-opt any other person or persons considered appropriate.
- 10 JUDGES, on entering the Showground shall proceed to the Secretary's office for instructions. The Chief Steward for the section will accompany the judge on his/her inspection. Upon completion of judging the judge shall sign his/her report which shall be conveyed to the Secretary under the direction of the Chief Steward. Judges shall make themselves available to members of the press after the completion of judging.
- 11 ENTRY FEES for each class shall be shown in the Schedule, and any entries not accompanied by the appropriate fees will be rejected.

ALL livestock entries, with the exception of Children's classes, must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor. All extra stock or exhibits lodged for exhibition only must be described and entered in the same manner as if intended for competition.

CONDITIONS

- a. All exhibits must be on the Showground and penned where applicable by not later than 8.00 am on the morning of the Show, unless otherwise stated.
- b. Exhibitors SHALL NOT be permitted to remove animals from the Showground before 3.00 pm on the Saturday of the Show without the authority of the Chief Steward of the Section and the President at the time of the show. Removal without authority may result in the forfeiture of any prize money or prizes payable.
- c. A Veterinary Surgeon attends the Show on both days, or is 'on call' for emergencies. In the event of an accident or injury to an animal at the Show, any exhibitor or competitor not using the services of the Veterinary Surgeon shall accept full responsibility for such a decision and the Society will not be deemed to have been involved in the matter or the decision. Any cost involved in the use of the Veterinary Surgeon or medications etc. provided shall be the responsibility of the exhibitor/competitor.
- d. The age of cattle shall be calculated from 1st June except as stated otherwise. All beasts calved before this date shall be deemed to be one year old on 1st June.
- e. All entries of applicable age must be registered with the respective Societies. Any exhibitor not adhering to the requirements of registration and code of ethics of their breed society shall have that particular exhibit disqualified.
- f. All entries, with the exception of Children's and Handler's classes must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor and must be entered in the owner's name. Irrespective of who may pay the entry fee or who receives the prize money, every animal exhibited to be judged MUST be entered in the name of the registered owner/s.
- g. Animals may only be entered for classes incorporating their own respective age group or groups as shown in the Schedule. Any animals entered in incorrect classes may be subject to disqualification. No animal shall be entered in more than one class with the exception of group classes.
- h. The Society reserves the right to restrict entries to TWO (2) per class per exhibitor.
- i. All bulls 12 months old or over shall have a nose ring and shall be handled with a lead attached to the nose ring. All cattle shall be tied up by neck straps.
- j. Any animal de-horned will not be penalised for points in the ring.
- k. No cow to be paraded with calf at foot older than 9 months of age at the date of the Show.
- l. Where there are insufficient entries in a particular breed to provide competition, the Society reserves the right to combine breeds for judging under OTHER BREEDS classification.
- m. Judging order will be at the direction of the Chief Steward.
- n. Exhibits must be paraded when reasonably requested by a Steward and refusal to parade shall render the exhibit and exhibitor liable to disqualification and the payment of a fine of \$20.00. No person/s, except Stewards and those actually in charge of exhibits (for whom an authority has been obtained) will be permitted to remain in the ring during adjudication. Persons in charge of exhibits shall not leave their respective exhibits unless authorised by the Chief Steward.
- o. Each column of the Entry Form must be completed and any class entered with only the word 'Entry' on the form will result in that particular class entry being rejected WITH THE EXCEPTION OF CLASSES WHERE A GROUP OF ANIMALS (TWO OR MORE) IS INVOLVED.
It is accepted that exhibitors select the animals to be exhibited in these classes at the most appropriate time.
- p. The Society's Grand Champion, Senior Champion, Reserve Senior Champion, Junior Champion and Reserve Junior Champion ribbons will be awarded subject to compliance with the Regulations and Conditions. Champion awards will not be given unless at least three (3) exhibits of a particular breed are entered, with a minimum of two (2) animals of such breed being duly shown. Where only one (1) exhibit of a particular breed is shown, the exhibit may be included in the Interbreed Section at the discretion of a majority of the judges.
- q. Cattle being judged in group classes will not be permitted to wear any prize ribbons that may have been awarded them when judged in other classes.
- r. Prize money or prizes will not be awarded to unworthy exhibits. Trophies may be substituted in lieu of prize money. Unless the judge reports that an exhibit (even though alone) is of exceptional quality, he may withhold the prize money or prize altogether.
- s. Where there are only two (2) competing entries in a class, first prize money only will be paid.
- t. Where there are only three (3) competing entries in a class, first and second prize money only will be paid.
- u. Prize money for first, second and third prize only will be paid where there are four (4) competing entries in a class.
- v. Where only one (1) entry is received in a class, the exhibitor (subject to any judge's ruling) shall be entitled to a refund of the entry fee.
- w. **EXHIBITORS SHALL NOT BE ALLOWED CLIPPING FRAMES INSIDE OF SHEDS**

Where there are insufficient entries in any category, the Society reserves the right to combine age groups.

There will be a maximum of fifteen (15) handlers per heat or class.

Neat and tidy dress, including safe footwear, must be worn.

Every handler must present to the judge/s and receive equal attention

Judges should take the following points into account -

Ability to lead

Appearance of handler

Positioning of halter

Preparation of animal

Type should NOT be taken into account.

The age of any beast used in handling events shall not exceed two (2) years.

HEIFERS only shall be used in the event.

Cattle used must be registered with the relevant breed society or be eligible for registration.

Once judging commences, no person other than those involved in this event shall be permitted in the ring, except where safety is a concern.

Class 1175 BEEF CATTLE JUDGING COMPETITION.
